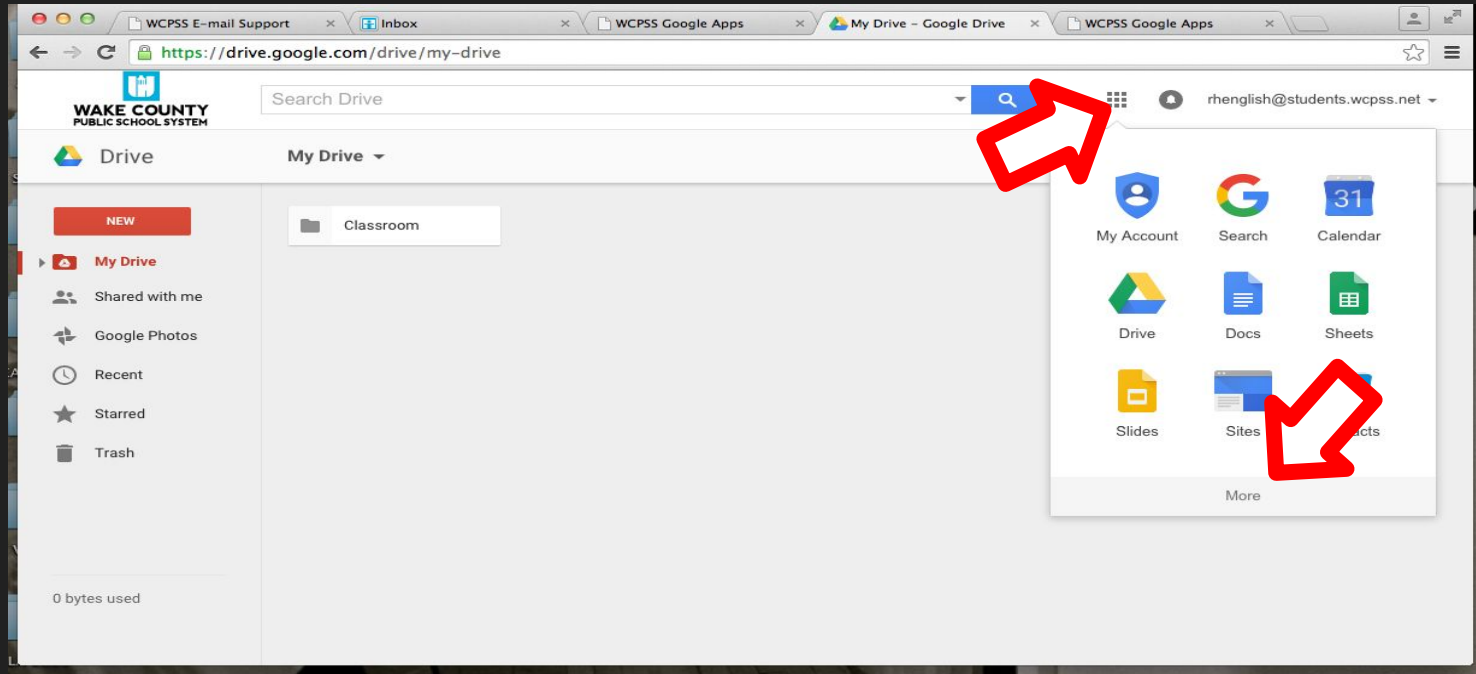


How to get to google classroom:

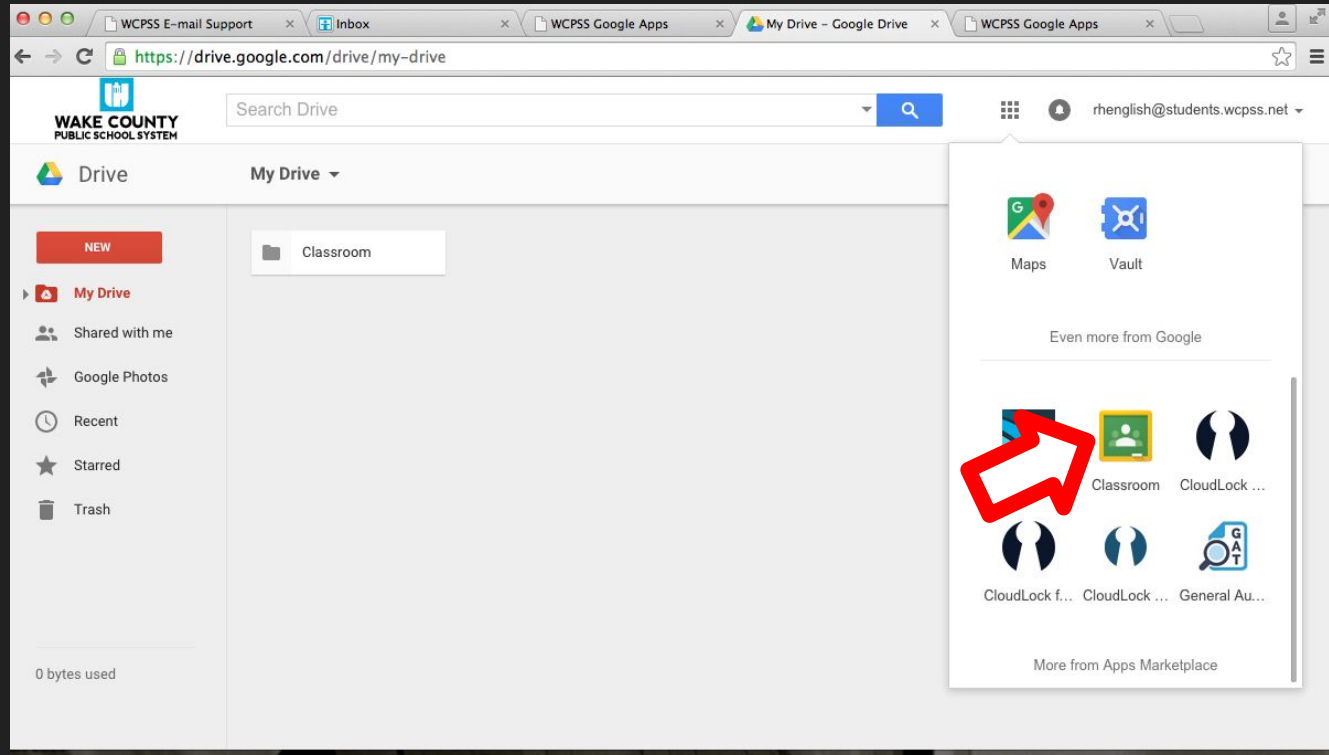
- Go to: www.msfergyla.weebly.com

How To Turn In Assignments!

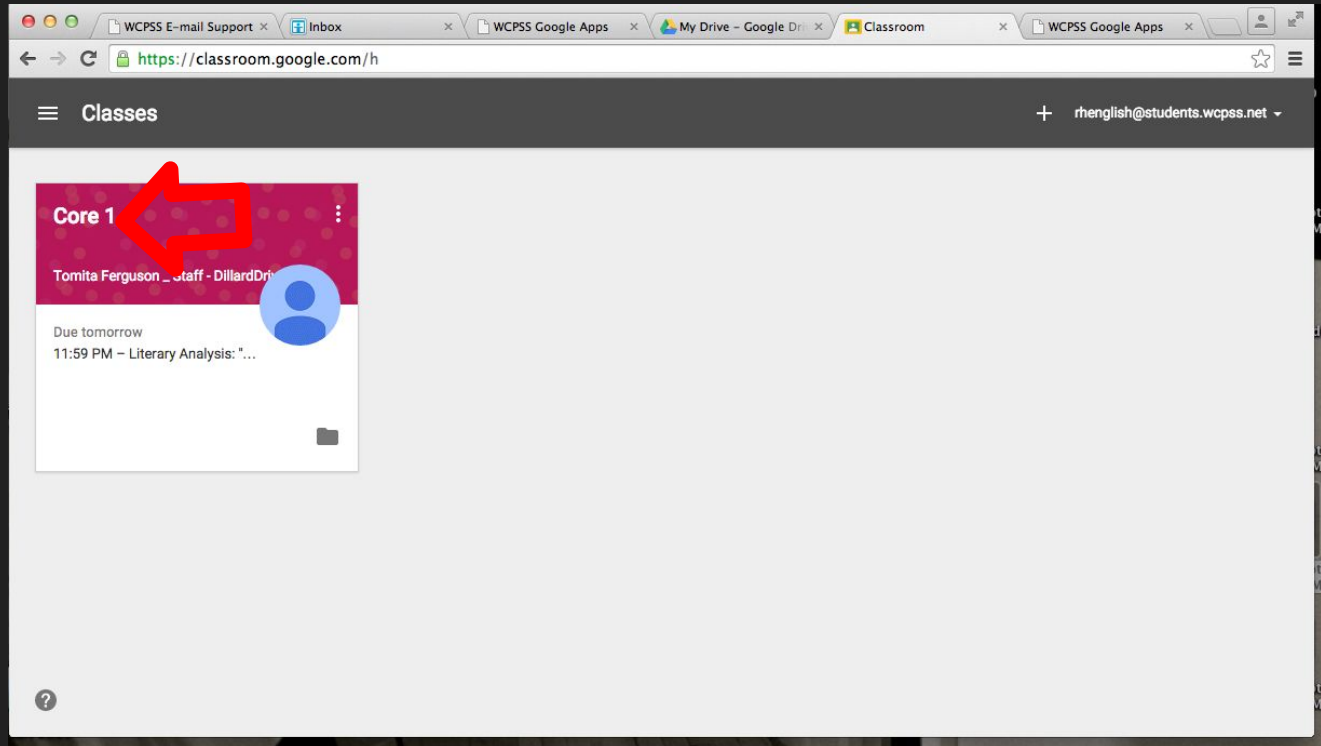
- Click on the **google app icon** (little squares) in the right corner

- Click on the class (either: core 1, core 2, core 3, or core 4)



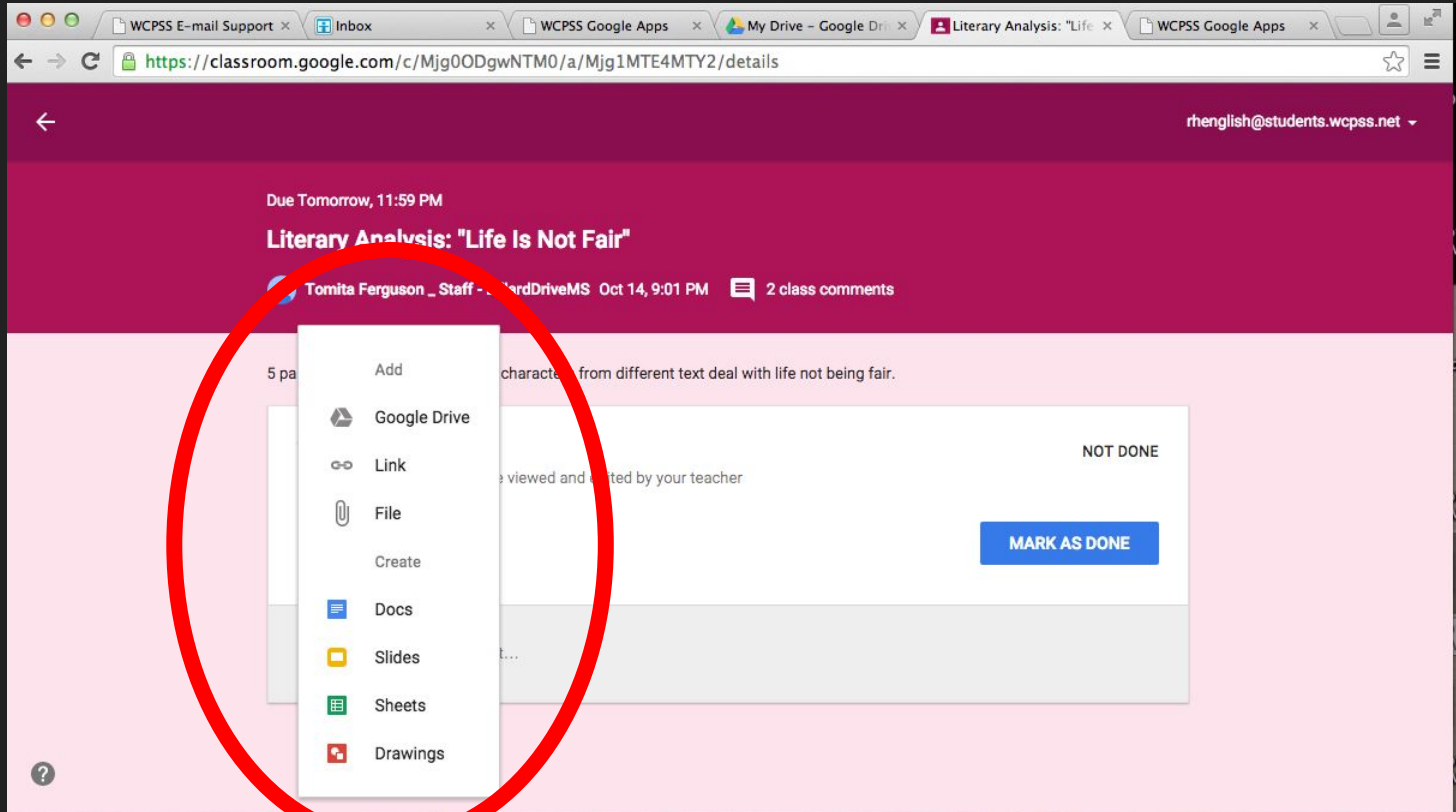
- Click on 'open'
